Domaine Achillée is an Alsatian estate led by brothers Jean and Pierre Dietrich, whose family has farmed in Scherwiller since 1600. While their father transitioned the 18.5 hectares to biodynamic farming decades ago, the brothers pivoted in 2016 to produce their own wines rather than selling grapes to cooperatives. They operate out of Europe's largest straw-bale cellar, a bioclimatic structure that maintains perfect temperatures without external energy. Their winemaking is defined by a low-intervention approach, utilizing indigenous yeast starters, no additives, and minimal sulfur to express the diverse gravel and granite terroirs of Alsace. This commitment to sustainability and precision earned them the Revue du Vin de France's Alsace Producer of the Year award in 2020.

Pépin is a modern natural wine collective founded by Pierre Dietrich of Domaine Achillée to democratize access to high-quality, low-intervention wines. Operating as a négociant project, it sources fruit from over fifteen independent organic growers across Alsace and France, bottling them under a label that eschews traditional markers like vintage dates or single-vineyard designations. The winemaking mirrors the strict standards of Achillée—native yeasts, no filtration, and zero added sulfur—but with a focus on accessibility and consistency across various 'lots' (Blanc, Rouge, Orange, and more). By stripping away the elitism often associated with natural wine, Pépin aims to prove that authentic, soulfully crafted wine can scale and remain affordable without compromising its integrity.

La Petite Odyssée is an estate created by Antoine Bernardin and based in Savignargue in Haute-Garonne. It is after a diploma as an oenologist that Antoine finds a position for a few months at Achillée. He then decided to settle in his native Haute Garonne and produce wines as cleanly as possible. In 2022, its estate reached 8 hectares, compared to 4 hectares 2 years ago. The vines are mainly planted on a terroir of pebbles from the Pyrenees. Juices without artifice, very digestible and representative of what the terroirs of this Southwest can bring us. He grows Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Chardonnay, and the rare local grape variety Abouriou.

We are two cousins who have two spots of winemaking (where we love the wines), one in the Muscadet where we buy the grapes and one in Burgundy (Maconnais) where we have our own vines (9ha) divided into 26 parcels in five appellations. We make manual harvests and let indigenous yeasts make the different fermentations, each parcel separately. We put no chemical input during the wine making process except a small amount of sulfur at the bottling, if necessary... Then we do not filter the wine.

Biodynamic vineyard about 8 hectares in Bordeaux. We cultivated traditional grape from our region such as merlot, cabernet franc, sémillon. We also cultivate Bouchales grape which is autochtone grape from the south west of France. In 2008, we stopped using herbicides and, starting in 2009, pesticides. Since 2010, we have been using alternative and natural treatments. Since 2013, all our wines have been certified organic (Ecocert), and we obtained biodynamic certification in 2017 (Demeter). The wines are vinified without additives: indigenous yeasts, no crushing, unfiltered, but sometimes fined (for whites only).

Art of Cellaring is a wine storage community and retail shop in San Antonio focused on growers, farming, and wines with a sense of place. We work closely with producers who farm responsibly and make wines with minimal intervention. Alongside retail and storage, we hold an importing license that allows us to bring in wines we believe should be represented in Texas. François Chidaine is a cornerstone producer for us. Long before 'natural wine' became a category, he was farming organically, working biodynamically, and fermenting with native yeasts. His wines are clean, energetic, and transparent expressions of Chenin Blanc grown on the limestone and clay soils of Montlouis and Vouvray.

Based in Poolesville, Maryland, Rocklands Farm Winery is a polycultural farm raising sheep and cows on pasture, growing 12 acres of vineyard, and producing low-intervention wines. Founded in 2010, Rocklands mission is to feed, nourish, and engage with a focus on direct to consumer relationships and local community. The winery produces about 35,000 bottles per year (the vast majority of which are sold on-site) split between about 12 to 15 different wines depending on the year. The grapes are grown both at the estate as well as sourced from two longstanding vineyard partners within an hour drive of Rocklands. 'Delicious wines transparent of time and place' is the mantra in the winery, as such, all fermentations are spontaneous, filtrations are rare, and sulfite additions are minimal or zero.

The Marigny is a small winery in the Willamette Valley that's focused on making what some folks call natural wine. Others call it 'real wine' or low intervention wine. We like to think of them as Modern Table Wines. For us, these are wines without pretense, meant to be enjoyed anytime, anywhere. They aren't a facsimile of another (oftentimes more iconic) wine that's been gussied up to be something it's not with oak chips and flavor enhancers. The Marigny wines simply are what they are: well farmed grapes processed gently and thoughtfully, then bottled with a little SO2 to get them across state lines. So open one up wherever you find your table... which could be your porch, the park, a backyard party or wherever else you let good times roll.

All fermentations are done by native yeast and bacteria with minimal sulfur use. These wines are intended to be a reflection of the Texas Hill Country.

Rocco di Carpeneto project was born in 2008-2009, as a result of a radical life change decision: we left Milan (we are not from Milan, anyway: Lidia comes from Rome, Paolo from Garda Lake, with deep roots in Veneto) walking off previous job together, with the idea to get back to nature -not only due to a shared wine passion: that's why we feel like we have nothing in common with the conventional wine world. Our wines are made up with sun, earth and our own passion only, in strict adherence to Upper Monferrato nature's pace and 'do nothing farming' or 'less is more' principles (no manure, no tilling). Vineyards are organically treated with very limited quantities of copper. Grapes are rigorously handpicked in small crates. All the fermentations are spontaneous -wild yeasts only. We do not use any additives. No filtration, no fining, no stabilisation, no temperature control.

We make wine in Francs, a small corner of Bordeaux that most people drive past on their way somewhere else. Francs is cooler and later-ripening than much of Bordeaux, with limestone soils and a pace that favors patience over force. We are finally making the wines we set out to make 15 years ago. We farm just over 6 hectares, all organic, focusing on reds and whites, some known and others that aren't typically associated with Bordeaux. Balance. Wines with precision and energy, not weight. In the end, this doesn't feel like starting over. It feels like arriving at the place where we get to solely focus on the work that matters in the vineyard and cellar.

Neki is responsible for the next year harvest, vintage and future of the vineyard. We/Neki try to source and bring into the American market small wineries with excellent wines expressing terroirs and personality of vignerons. We boast to have probably the best collection of Georgian wines and hope to build a long and sustainable wine business here in the USA.

Villa Picta is a small, 3.8 hectare natural winery located in the province of Mantova, Lombardy, built from the ground up by vignaiolo Paolo Pasini. Begun in 2015 and with the first wines being released in 2018, Villa Picta exists in an unusual geographical location in northern Italy. Here in the wide open plains of the Po river valley, cool, foggy winters and underground springs lend themselves to the viticultural tradition you usually see instead in Emilia: that of Lambrusco. Sparkling wines made with secondary fermentation in bottle, called rifermentati, are the focus at Villa Picta, with each step of the process being done by hand and with very little fancy modern technology. Farming is certified organic and then some, with a strong emphasis on progressive, detailed pruning techniques and lots of time actually in the vines. The second partner at the winery, Amanda Smeltz, joined Paolo in life and work as of 2024, and the duo are excited to share these wines in Texas for the very first time.
